18TH INTER - SCHOOL MULTI - TALENT COMPETITION : 2019

1. **YOGA-ASANA : On Wednesday, Dec. 12th 2018 (Team Event)**

ELIGIBILITY : Students (Girls & Boys)

Time : 9.00 a.m.

Categories : Junior Group (Std. V to VII)
Senior Group (Std. VIII to X)

Dress Code : Decent Loose Fitting clothes, Boys : Track Suit. Girls : Salwar Kameez or Track Suit.

Surya Namaskar : Students will have to demonstrate 2 rounds of Sashtang Namaskar also commonly known as Surya Namaskar

Asanas : After Surya Namaskar students will have to demonstrate any three Asanas of their choice.

Time Allotted : 5 minutes for total presentation.

Each school can send three students per group.

All students from the same school will perform together in their respective groups.

2. **DEVOTIONAL SONGS : On Thursday, Dec. 13th, 2018 (Individual Event)**

ELIGIBILITY : Students (Girls & Boys)

9.00 a.m. : Junior Group (Std. IV to VI)

1.00 p.m. : Senior Group (Std. VII to IX)

Types of Songs : Devotional Songs (In any Language)

Time Allotted : 2-3 minutes for each participant.

General : Open only to amateurs and not for those performing on All-India Radio, T.V. etc. Each School can send 8 entries (2 in each group) (Jr. Girls / Boys, Sr. Girls / Boys).

The participants will not be allowed to use any musical instruments.

3. **DRAWING : On Friday, Dec 14th, 2018 (Individual Event)**

ELIGIBILITY : Students (Girls & Boys)

9.00 a.m. : Junior Boys & Girls (IV - VI)

1.00 p.m. : Senior Boys & Girls (VII - IX)

Each school can send 8 entries (2 in each group) (Jr. Girls / Boys, Sr. Girls / Boys).

Time Allotted : 2 hours

Theme/Topic :

For Juniors : 1. Fearlessness

(Std. IV to VI) : 2. Swamiji's Historic Speech

For Seniors : 1. Swamiji Practised What He Preached

(Std. VII to IX) : 2. A Hero's Welcome

Schools should collect the above-mentioned themes, two each for Junior and Senior groups, in advance on the life and teachings of Swami Vivekananda. The participants of the respective groups have to choose any one theme.

Requirements : The organizers will provide only one sheet of drawing paper (11"X 15" size). The participants should bring their own drawing material, i.e. crayons, water or pastel colours, brushes, palettes etc.

IMP Note : Participants (Juniors & Seniors) are free to choose any medium of their choice like Crayons, Oil Pastels, Water and Poster Colours, etc. or Mixed Media.

The drawings will be the exclusive property of the organizers and will not be returned to the participants.

Assessment : This will be made on the basis of composition / colour scheme / finish.

4. **QUIZ : On Saturday, Dec. 15th, 2018 (Team Event)**

ELIGIBILITY : Students (Girls & Boys) only Senior Group
(Std. VII to STD IX)

Time : 9.00 a.m.

Language : English

Study Material : Quiz booklets containing questions and answers on the life and teachings of Swami

Vivekananda will be provided to schools on request for distribution to the participants. Please indicate your requirement of quiz booklets at the earliest. **Please note that any number of students can participate in the preliminary round. Kindly arrange to collect the books for the Preliminary & Final Round as it is not feasible for us to send it to your school.**

Preliminary round :

- The preliminary round of quiz, based on the quiz booklets supplied, is to be conducted by the school itself on any convenient day on or before **Saturday, November 24, 2018.**
- We will also supply the question papers for the preliminary round of written quiz, which are to be kept confidential till the time of the quiz.
- These papers are to be evaluated by the school teachers at their respective schools.
- The schools are requested to return the evaluated papers of the first three top-ranking students to us on or before **Monday, December 3, 2018** and collect the set of three prescribed books, one each for three top rankers, for the following final round.
- We will supply the books free to each participating school.

Final Round (At Ramakrishna Math, Khar) : on Saturday, December 15th, 2018.

- a. The team comprising 3 top-ranking students representing their school shall participate in the Final Round of Inter - School Quiz Contest.
- b. The students are required to prepare for the final round of quiz from the quiz booklets and other prescribed books supplied by us.

Awards : Three top-ranking schools and the participants from these respective schools will be awarded trophies / prizes.

5. **POWER POINT PRESENTATION : On Sunday, December 16th, 2018. (Team Event)**

ELIGIBILITY : Students (Girls & Boys) Standard VII to IX

Time : 9.00 a.m.

Language : English

FORMAT OF THE COMPETITION :

1. This competition is open to school students of standard VII to IX.
2. The participants of the competition are required to make a Power Point Presentation on the topic: **1893 – Swami Vivekananda at the World Parliament of Religions in Chicago.**
3. Three students of the **same school** have to form a group.
4. The presentation has to be made by the group.
5. The PPT has to be made in any version upto **2016.**
6. The PPT can consist of relevant photos, graphics, words and even music.
7. Any two students can speak at the competition. A stop sign will be displayed after 8 minutes, when the PPT has to end.
8. Students should not continue after the Stop sign. Marks will be deducted if the students continue with the presentation after Stop sign.
9. There is no restriction on the number of slides which the group can make. However, all slides should be shown within the allotted time of 8 minutes per group.
10. **The names of the participants should be sent to us before Saturday, 8th December, 2018.**
11. **Students are not allowed to copy any animation clips, video clips from the net or other sources.**
12. **The students have to bring their PPT in a pen-drive on the day of the competition. They do not have to mail it to us.**

JUDGING STANDARDS :

1. The presentation will be judged by a team of three competent judges whose decision shall be final and binding.
2. Maximum marks will be 100.

AWARDS : Prizes will be for the Winner and Runner-up teams.

Individual prizes will be given to the students and trophy will be presented to the Best School.
